



Heap's Sunflower Harvest Photography Policy

Friends & Family Photos (non-paid photographers)

- Photos allowed during business hours only.
 - Wristbands must be purchased to enter the Sunflower field.
 - Photos are allowed only in public areas of the farm.
- Please DO NOT:
- Enter any no access, private, Do Not Enter or areas with working farm equipment.
 - Destroy in any way the sunflower field.

Professional Photographers

We welcome those who wish to use Heap Farms as a backdrop/setting for any portrait/commercial photography, even if the photographer is not compensated, financially or otherwise.

- Portrait photography is defined as, but not limited to: senior, engagement, family, graduation, wedding, etc.
- Commercial photography is defined as, but not limited to: catalog, fashion, advertisement, promotion, etc.

Photographer Requirements:

- Professional Photography sessions are limited to 8 per day. To ensure your spot, purchase the \$50 Daily Photography Pass ahead of time. Anyone assisting the photographer must pay for a daily wristband.

- All photographers must check in at our Ticket Booth and obtain a photographer's lanyard prior to your first session each day. Please return this lanyard to the Ticket Booth at the end of each visit. This lanyard must be clearly displayed at all times.
- Everyone entering Heap's Sunflower Harvest must purchase a daily wristband. This includes people who are being photographed and those joining them during the session.
- Photography sessions can only take place during our regular business hours. Absolutely NO sessions after business hours.
- You can only access the PUBLIC parts of the Farm. You may NOT enter any of the areas marked No Access, Do Not Enter, or areas with working farm equipment.

Farm Rules:

Please respect all farm property including the grounds, crops growing, animals and all other aspects of our farm's environment. Failure to do so will result in immediate dismissal from the farm.

- Please supervise children at all times, this includes photographer's own children, while on Heap's Farm property. Also, ensure they are not injuring plants and items that are growing in any way.
- Nothing may be picked and used during your session for props. Daily wristbands include one sunflower bloom and additional can be picked and purchased during your visit. All sunflowers picked must be purchased.

Photography Session Rules:

- Multiple clothes changes on site are not appropriate as these can interfere with our other guests.
- All props, must be carried to your photoshoot location. Props or equipment that cannot be carried easily should not be used. All props must be removed upon departure.
- We require that all trash is removed from your photo site.
- The use of drones is strictly prohibited.
- All photos should be family friendly in nature.
- No public area may be closed or blocked to customers during regular business hours during a photo shoot.
- Please be courteous and polite to all visitors and customers.
- Our Staff is not responsible for directing clients to your photo shoot location within the field. Make sure your clients have your cell phone so that they can contact you upon their arrival.
- Heap's Giant Pumpkin Farm reserves the right to halt any photography sessions deemed to be disruptive.
- Heap's Giant Pumpkin Farm assumes no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to any equipment or belongings.

Any unauthorized portrait/commercial photography sessions will be escorted from the farm.
